Other Notations:

- Trills (*tr*) are frequently used.
- Accents (*>*) are used on notes.
- Slurs are used to group notes.
- Dynamic markings (*f*, *mf*, *p*, *ff*) are used to indicate volume.
- Tempo/mood markings (*vigoroso*, *brillante*, *misterioso*, *majestuoso*, *grandioso*) are used to indicate the character of the music.
